Pet Squad - Week 2 — Need to Know: A heart after God Serves Others

Our Bible Story for Today: David Serves Saul (1 Samuel 16:4-23)

Ask Your Child...

- **Even though David knew he would become king one day, did he still serve King Saul?**
(Yes!) David knew God had chosen him, but he didn't let it go to his head or expect others to serve him. Instead, David chose to serve others.
- **How did David serve King Saul in the story?** (By playing the harp for him.)
That's right! When David played the harp, it helped Saul feel calm and better.

💬 **Talk About It Together:** David used his gift to help someone who was having a hard time. Talk about how serving others shows that we have a heart after God and care about the people around us.

- Pray together this week and ask God to help you serve in a new way this week
Challenge: Find one way each day to serve someone in your family, at school, or church.
