Peace, Grand Island is hosting a Civilian Response to Active Killer Event (CRAKE) training on May 5th at 10:00 a.m.

This event will be led by representatives from the Nebraska State Patrol. The Civilian Response to Active Killer Events (CRAKE) program was developed to provide information on awareness and steps a civilian can take to increase their safety in these horrific situations. CRAKE focuses on three steps: Avoid, Deny, and Defend. "This training is designed specifically for civilians to know how to react in the worst situations," said Colonel John Bolduc, Superintendent of the Nebraska State Patrol. If you have interest in attending, there is a sign up sheet in the fellowship hall. There is no cost and the training goes until noon. We will try to arrange a car pool of those going.
