The Civilian Response to Active Killer Events (CRAKE) program was developed to provide information on awareness and steps a civilian can take to increase their safety in these horrific situations. CRAKE focuses on three steps: Avoid, Deny, and Defend. "This training is designed specifically for civilians to know how to react in the worst situations," said Colonel John Bolduc, Superintendent of the Nebraska State Patrol.
