

Family Devotional Week 4

Virtue:

Humility

Scripture Verse:

"Don't do anything only to get ahead. Don't do it because you are proud. Instead, be humble. Value others more than yourselves."
Philippians 2:3 (NirV)

Devotional Thought:

1 Peter 5:5 says that, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble." Being proud is the opposite of being humble. Pride is a feeling that puts you first, sometimes at the expense of others. One example is King Nebuchadnezzar in the Old Testament. He was so proud that God took his kingdom away from him. God takes pride very seriously. That also means that God takes a humble attitude seriously too! Do your best to choose a humble attitude today!
