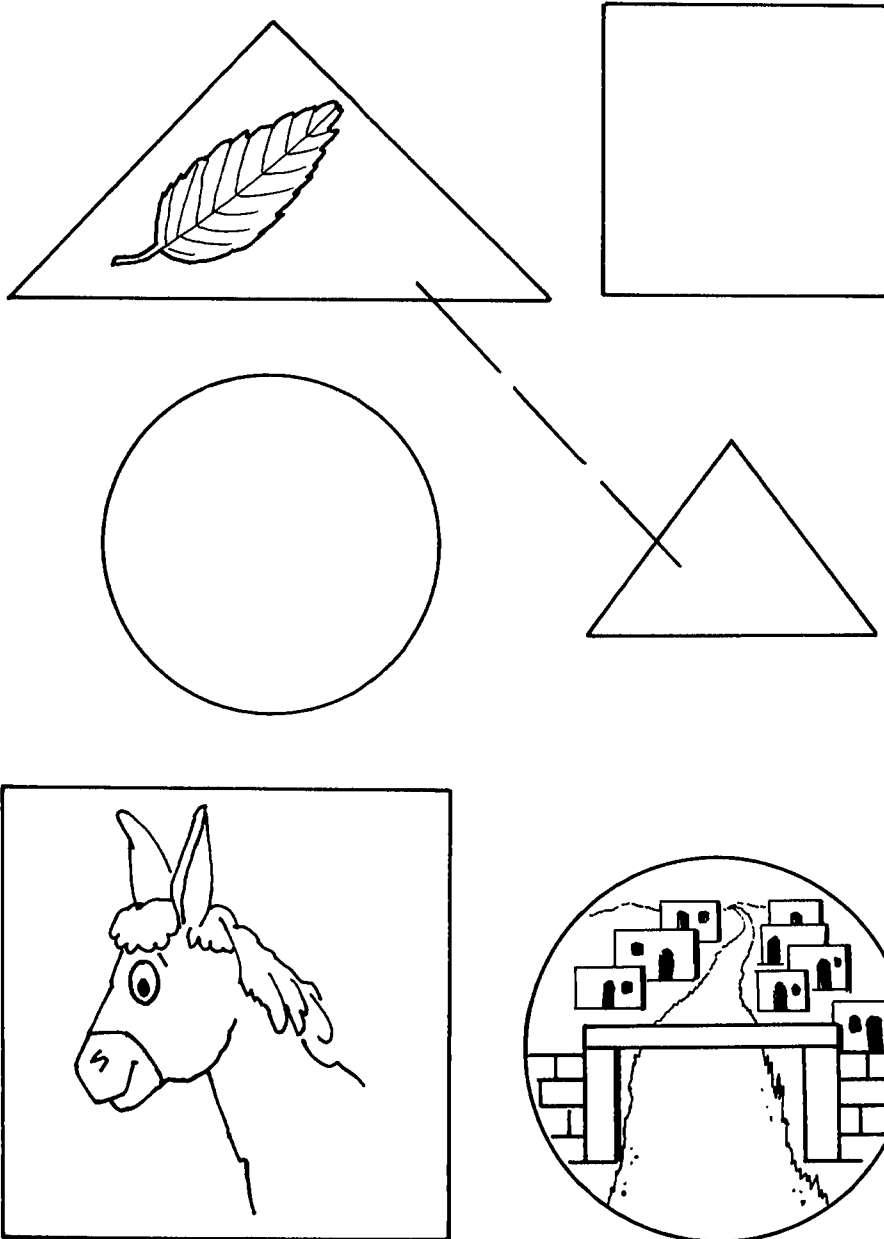


Draw a line between the shapes that match.

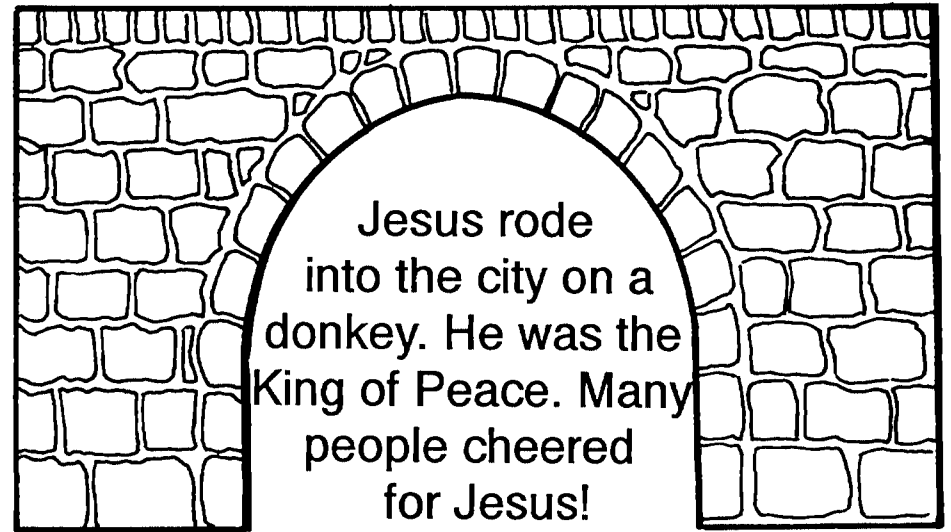

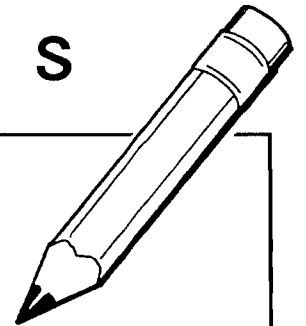

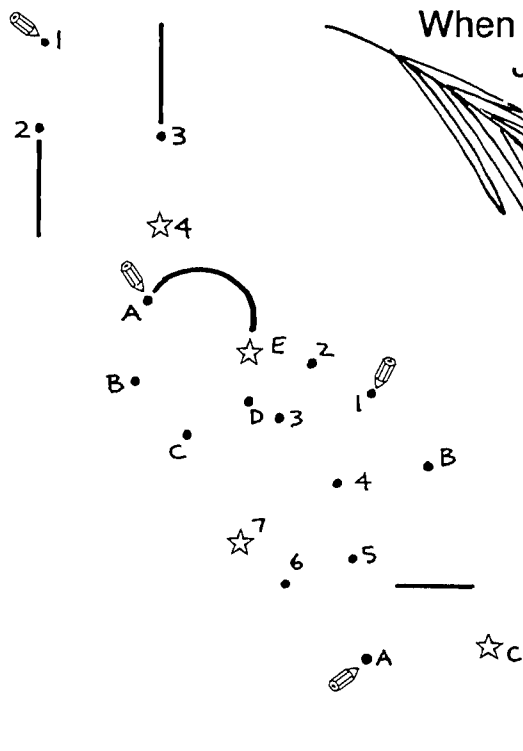

When Jesus came into Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover feast, the crowd of people shouted a word that means "Save now" or "God save the King!"

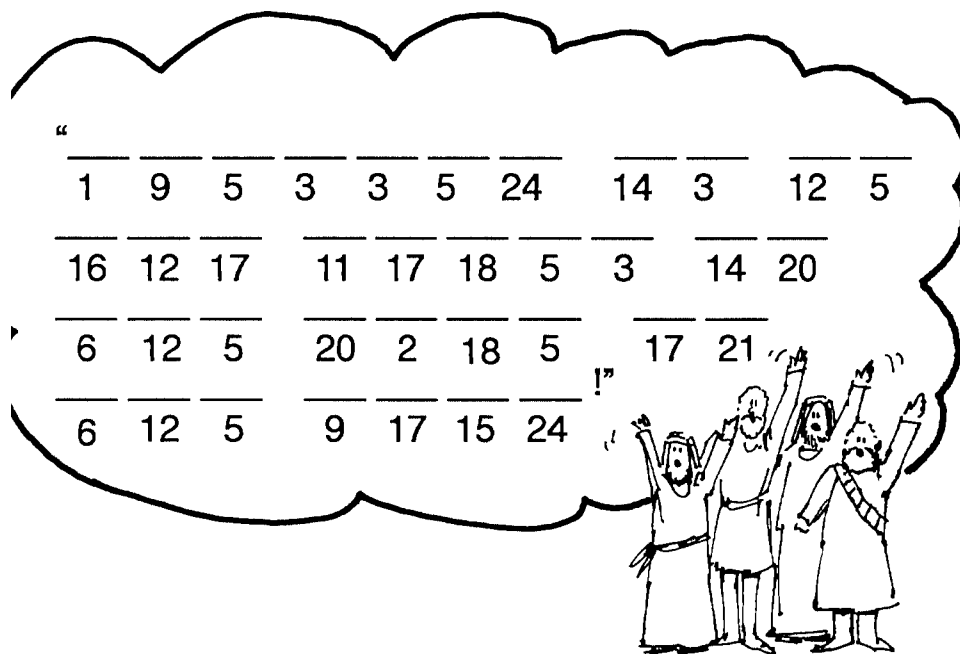


Connect each set of dots. Each one starts at a pencil and ends at a star.
