



Hello on this *cool* winter morning. The Preschool teachers are busy getting ready for an exciting and interesting February. We will focus on love with Valentine's Day just around the corner. The children and teachers are sharing ideas on ways to show and receive love from others. We will be singing songs and telling stories from the Bible about love and caring for others.

We will talk about showing love to God, our families and friends, not only with words but also with deeds. We will discuss that friends love at all times, not just the good times. God loves us and provides for us, and it is loving to forgive those who hurt our feelings. We will continue to emphasize acts of kindness and politeness as ways of showing love. While we practice these ideas at Preschool, please encourage them at home. Take time with your child to show him/her how much you love them. Give hugs and kisses and say "I love you". Choose a special word, signal or gesture of affection that only your family knows. These are a few ideas that show your child they are



special and loved by you.


