



Kreider Fellow Samuel Dali and Snowden Fellow Rebecca Dali will share stories of pain and hope from the Boko Haram crisis and the church's response. Samuel Dali will offer an update on the situation of the Ekklesiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria (CoB in Nigeria) in the context of ongoing violence in northeastern Nigeria and reflect on the church's constructive engagement around sociopolitical, economic, and environmental issues that contribute to the possibility of peace in the region.
