## Statement from Leadership on reopening the church. IN PERSON SERVICES scheduled to resume June 28th

Greetings Little Swatara Church of the Brethren Congregation;

We are eager to come together in person for worship and the Leadership Team is prayerfully working towards creating a plan to meet together. This will continue to be a work in progress. We are aware not everyone will be comfortable meeting at church, and this is okay. We will continue to offer live streaming and have CD's available by request.

We have established suggested guidelines for reopening in the hope to offer physical safety for at-risk members of the congregation while providing opportunity to meet together. We desire to continue to observe recommendations from the government on safety measures out of respect for one another.

We will be initially starting with one service on Sunday, June 28 at 10:30 AM, no Sunday School.

#### Procedures for attending:

- We request you wear masks when entering and exiting the building. Please enter the church from the North and South side at the carport --- doors will be propped open. Please proceed to the sanctuary via the elevator if necessary or use of the tower stairwell. (Doors on East side and at kitchen entrance will remain locked)
- Please proceed directly to the sanctuary and find a seat in the marked pews. Families should arrive together and sit together. If you have questions about where to sit, there will be ushers available to offer assistance. Please seat yourself 6 feet from other family groups as possible.
- The nursery will not be staffed, but it is available for diaper changes.
- There will not initially be extended session.
- We request you wear masks while singing, and sing softly. All hymnals and Bibles have been removed from the pews and words will be projected on the screen. Please feel free to bring your own Bible and hymnal to worship.
- Offering plates will be located in the rear of the sanctuary.
- Following the service, ushers will dismiss the congregation starting at the back of the sanctuary.
- Children's Sunday School packets will be available for pick up in the back of the sanctuary.
- Water Fountains will not be available. The bathrooms will be available for use doors will be propped open.
- If you are sick, please do not come to services in person, but join us online.
- Please practice social distancing and do not linger inside the church.

At this time Leadership has decided to allow small groups of less than 25 to meet at church for meetings, quilting, etc. We ask that you contact Pam Gerberich or Gary Bashore if you are planning to meet at the church. Anyone meeting at church is asked to observe social distancing, clean areas prior to leaving, wear face masks.
