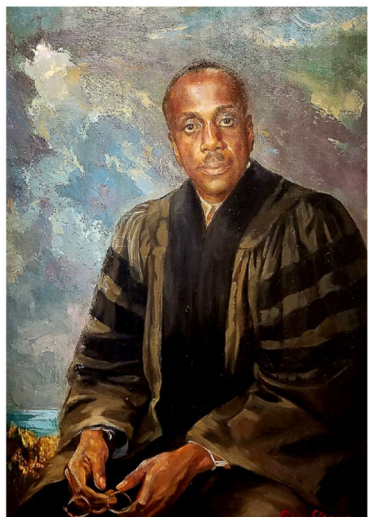


# BLACK HISTORY MONTH AT FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF KCMO
