Luke 2:22-38

When Jesus was born, he was born into a world that was moving at a very fast pace. September of 04 B.C. was a busy time of the year.

Luke 2:1–7ESV

It's easy to miss what God is doing around you if you are focused on everything else.

Luke 2:22–25 ESV

In the midst of all that was going on Simeon was focused on the things of God.

- He was righteous meaning he walked with the Lord.
- He was devout meaning he cared more about the things of God than anything else.
- He was waiting for the promises of God in faith knowing that God was at work.
- He was filled with the Holy Spirit meaning he was in communication with God and walking in His power.

Luke 2:26-32 ESV

You will never see God at work around you if you don't open your eyes and look for Him.

Matthew 13:13-17 ESV

So how do we get eyes to see?

- 1. Be intentional about building your relationship with God and draw close to him. (Righteous)**
- 2. Seek the Lord with all your heart and you will find Him. (Devout)**
- 3. Be looking for the promises of God know He is faithful who has promised. Focus your mind on the coming of the Lord.**
- 4. Be led by the Holy Spirit of God and he will reveal the plans of heaven to you allowing you to join Him in his work.**

For many this is a new concept. You need to pray to the Lord as Jesus commands to the Churches in Revelation 3:18
