

Disciples Making Disciples Sharing the Good News in Our World Today

From the Beginning

Where does discipleship start? Many people would say, "Discipleship begins in the church." If this is your answer, you are wrong. Listen to what Deuteronomy 6:4-9 says:

Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commands that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the door frames of your houses and your gates.

That's right. Discipleship begins in the home. Mom and Dad begin transferring their values into their children's hearts and minds from the moment they bring them home. This investment and training are discipling. The question is not, "Are you making disciples in your home?" but "What kind of disciples are you making in your home?"You influence and shape how your children see the world and how they interact with it while affirming a standard of success and failure. By modeling accountability, instruction, and transparency, every parent communicates what he or she values.

Even if your children are older, it's not too late. Do not let the world disciple your children. Be the influence God wants you to be starting now. It's never too late.
