## From the Pastor's Pen:

Are we there yet? Many a parent has heard these words from the backseat while going from one place to another. Are we there yet, how much longer, when is this going to be over?

Oh, how many of us have said this a time or two. Sitting in a dentist chair gripping the armrest as the drill makes contact with a nerve for the umpteenth time. Waiting on a plane as it takes its place in line on the runway as the captain informs that there will be a small delay, a delay that is now threatening our connection at our next stop. Spending most of a day waiting on the service tech to arrive knowing that the eta was somewhere between 8 am and 8 pm. These little inconveniences remind us that there is much in our lives that we are not in control of, and this can lead to impatience, anxiety and a sense of hopelessness.

Oh, if only our lives were like those television shows that wrapped everything up in less than thirty minutes to an hour. Shows like "Leave it to Beaver," "Laverne and Shirley," and even "Gilligan's Island." But our

lives are not television shows no matter how much reality is claimed. Our lives are real and the issues and challenges we face are real and they are not always fixed in a neat and expected time frame.



# Disciples Making Disciples Sharing the Good News in Our World Today

If we want to be disciples who help other people along the way to becoming disciples, then we will first invite them along the way that we are traveling. In a spiritual sense, that would be the disciple's path. If you were sitting in a theology class and I was the professor, I would say we are going to look at the "doctrine of sanctification." But I am just a simple retired preacher, so I'm going to say we are going to look at the way toward spiritual maturity. The Bible often refers to this as "The Way." What is the "Way?" It is the method and message of Jesus, and it is this method and message that we use to bring others along the way toward spiritual maturity.

Jesus said In John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth, and the life." If we are a part of Jesus' church and we are walking the path he has for us, then we are already

on "the Way" toward being transformed into the image of Christ. Spiritual maturity is never accidental, nor does it occur in isolation from other brothers and sisters in the local church.

The book of Acts calls Jesus' Church "the Way," the phrase indicates that the people of Christ's first-century church contributed to intentional partnerships to help each other along this path of growth. There are three steppingstones that help us along this way and thus help us bring others along with us. We cannot travel this path without these three hallmarks of Jesus' teaching. They are: The Great Confession (Matthew 16), the Great Commandment (Matthew 22), and the Great Commission (Matthew 28). We will look at each of these more closely in the coming months.
