You have to ask yourself: "Am I a Catholic because the <u>Bible verifies</u> the truth of <u>Catholicism</u> and Catholic teaching, OR am I a Catholic because the <u>Catholic Church</u> is the source of and <u>authorizes</u> the <u>Bible</u> (as Catholicism teaches)?"

- 1) **Rev 22:18** For I testify together *to* everyone who hears the Words of the prophecy of this Book: <u>If anyone adds</u> to these things, <u>God will add</u> on him <u>the plagues</u> that have been written in this Book.
- 2) **1 Jn 2:1** My little children, I write these things to you *so* that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we <u>have an Advocate</u> with the Father, <u>Jesus Christ</u> *the* righteous.
- 3) Heb 6:6 and who have fallen away; it is <u>impossible</u>, I say, <u>to renew them</u> again <u>to repentance</u>, <u>since</u> they <u>crucify the</u> <u>Son of God afresh</u> to themselves and put *Him* to an open shame.
- 4) **1 Tim 2:5** For God *is* one, and *there is* <u>one</u> <u>Mediator</u> of God and of men, *the* Man Christ Jesus
- 5) Luke 1:46, 47 And <u>Mary said</u>, My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit has rejoiced in God <u>my Savior</u>.

[She would only have needed a Savior if she was a sinner like the rest of us.]

- 6) Matt 6:7 But when you pray, <u>do not keep</u> <u>repeating yourselves</u>, as the nations. For they think that in their <u>much speaking</u> they shall be heard.
- 7) Matt 23:9 And <u>call no one</u> your <u>father</u> on the earth, for One is your Father in Heaven.
- 8) 1 Tim 4:1 Now the Spirit explicitly says, that in latter times some will fall away from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,
 1 Tim 4:2 speaking lies in hypocrisy, having been seared with a hot iron as to their own conscience,
 1 Tim 4:3 forbidding to marry ...
- **9) Exod 20:4** You shall <u>not make</u> to yourselves <u>any graven</u> <u>image</u>, or any likeness of *anything* that *is* in the heavens above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth.

* This verse is *missing* from Catholic publications of the 10 Commandments!

- 10) **Heb 9:4** And there were in it the <u>golden censer</u> and the ark of the covenant, ... Heb 9:9 and it was <u>a symbol, for that time</u>, during which oblation and sacrifices were offered that <u>could not make perfect</u> the conscience of him who offered them:
- 11) Jer 23:16 So says Jehovah of Hosts, Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you; they make you vain; they speak a <u>vision of their own heart</u>, not out of the mouth of Jehovah. 17 They say to those who despise Me, Jehovah has said, You shall have peace. And they say to everyone who walks in the stubbornness of his own heart, Evil shall not come on you.
- 12) Jer 44:17 But we will certainly do whatever thing goes forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense to the <u>Queen</u> <u>of Heaven</u>, and to pour out drink offerings to her, as we have done, we, and our fathers, our kings, and our rulers, in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem. *For* then we had plenty of food, and were well, and saw no evil.
- 13) **1 Cor 3:5** <u>Who</u> then <u>is Paul</u>, and who *is* <u>Apollos</u>, <u>but</u> <u>ministers</u> by whom you believed, even as the Lord gave to each?
- 14) Eph 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, <u>to the saints</u> who are at Ephesus, and faithful in Christ Jesus:
- 15) Ezek 13:6 They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, "the LORD says." And the LORD has not sent them; but they hoped to confirm *their* word.
- 16) 1 Tim 3:2 It is <u>necessary</u>, therefore, for a <u>bishop</u> to <u>be</u> <u>irreproachable</u>, the husband of one wife, temperate, soberminded, well-behaved, hospitable, skillful at teaching; 1Ti 3:7 Moreover he <u>must have a good testimony among</u> <u>those outside</u>, lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.
