God is continuing to richly bless us in every way. Let us continue to trust God in every area of ministry and in every area of our lives. To God be the Glory.

Let me encourage you to pray for our Parking Lot Ministry Teams our S.O.S. Teams and our Campers on Mission as they share the Gospel during the Strawberry Festival Mar 1-11, 2018. Pray that many will come to Christ and lives will be changed for eternity. Over the last 14 years we have seen over 3200 folks come to Jesus through these ministries.

Let me also encourage you to pray and give generously to our Annie Armstrong Easter Offering. The National Goal is \$70 million. Our Church Goal is \$4,300.00 and the emphasis will be from Apr. 1-30, 2018. We give to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering to help our Home Missionary Force of over 5,000 Missionaries reach for Christ an estimated 260 million lost people in the United States and Canada; that's three out of four people. 100% of the Offering given is used to support our missionaries and their work.
