FORGIVES: God is gracious and merciful beyond measure (Neh. 9:31). At the time of salvation, God graciously stands ready and eager to forgive me as I: (1) confess my wretchedness, (2) ask for His forgiveness by acknowledging my only hope for my standing with Him to be Christ's undeserved substitutionary payment for my sin, and (3) submit to His rule over my life. He was/is awesomely gracious and merciful to the undeserving by providing a plan of forgiveness/reconciliation (restoration of relationship) APART FROM ONES PERSONAL MERIT!

This forgiveness/reconciliation continues to be effectual for the forgiveness of my daily sins. At the time of true salvation, my sins are paid for, past, present, and future, which Christ acknowledges before the Father. When I sin as a believer, the Holy Spirit *is* grieved, God's full grace for living is hindered, my joyful walk with Him *is* hindered (on my end), Christ *is* troubled (because He suffered to rid my life of sin and because I am NOT abiding in His love) and God *is not* glorified as He should be. However, my standing with God, his love and commitment to me, His desire to walk with me in joy and supply all I need, His working to help me repent and grow and His presence are NOT affected in the least because I am in Christ. My standing and basic relationship was not gained by my works; neither can it be retained or changed by my works. After salvation, God NO LONGER deals with me as a guilty criminal, but as His child, WHOM HE NEVER FORSAKES. He loves me with the same love that He loves Christ with because I am in Him. There is need to confess, repent (change) and recognize forgiveness through His death, but we are not on a treadmill to work for His acceptance, love or forgiveness. We can ask for forgiveness relationally for choosing to disobey and turn away from His love, but not ask positionally, to regain our standing and His love. It is not lost because of the Cross!
