

Passover To The Cross - Part 8

Jesus and His disciples stop at Lazarus' house on their way to Jerusalem for Passover - John 12:1-2

Mary anoints Jesus feet - John 12:3-8

Judas had been taking money from the money bag - John 12:6

Jesus says Mary did this for His burial - John 12:7

Triumphal Entry - John 12:12-19 / Matthew 21:1-11 / Luke 19:28-40

-Jesus found a young donkey to ride on - John 12:14

-A kings welcome - John 12:12-14

-Jesus says, "I tell you, if these were silent, the very stones would cry out"
Luke 19:40

Mary the mother of Jesus and John's mother and other women travelled with Jesus and the disciples at times - Matthew 27:55/Mark 15:41/Luke 8:3

Jesus taught openly every day in the temple that week - Luke 21:37,38/John 18:20

Temple guards didn't arrest Jesus for fear of the crowds - John 7:25-30

One temple guard interested in Jesus teachings - John 7:45-52

Nicodemus, Joseph of Arimathea and other Jewish leaders believed but would not stand up for Jesus yet - John 3:1-15/John 7:50-52/John 12:42-43/John 19:38-39

The Last Supper - Matthew 26:17-35/Mark 14:12-31/Luke 1-38/John 13
-Peter and John sent ahead to prepare the meal/room - Luke 22:8
-Disciples were talking about who will be the greatest in the kingdom
Luke 22:24-30
-Jesus washed His disciples feet - John 13:1-20
-Jesus says, "One of you will betray Me" - John 13:21
-Jesus interaction with Judas before he leaves - John 13:26-30
-Jesus says the wine is His blood and the bread is His body - Mark 14:22-25
-Singing 'This is the day the LORD has made, we will rejoice and be glad in it'
Psalm 118:24 (this was a psalm sung at Passover)

Jesus and the disciples went to the garden on the Mt. of Olives each night together -
Luke 21:37-38/Luke 22:39

Jesus asked Peter, James and John to go further with Him into the garden - Mark
14:33

The disciples fell asleep three times while praying - Mark 14:41

Jesus woke them by calling out Peter's name first - Mark 14:37

Jesus had sweat and blood on his face - Luke 22:44

Jesus prayed with loud groaning and tears - Hebrews 5:7

Jesus prayed, "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not
my will, but yours, be done." - Matthew 26:39-42/Luke 22:42

A crowd came to the garden carrying swords and clubs, torches and lanterns
- Mark 14:43/John 18:2-3

Judas betrays Jesus with a kiss - Luke 22:47-48/John 18:2-3

Jesus knocks all of them down by saying "I am He" - John 18:6

Peter cuts off the man's ear - John 18:10-11/Luke 22:51

Disciples all run away and leave Jesus alone - Matthew 26:56/Mark 14:50

Jesus is taken to the high priest's house - Matthew 26:57/Mark 14:53

John knew the door keeper at the high priest's house - John 18:15

One of the guards may have felt called out by Jesus - John 7:25-30/John 18:10-23

Jesus accused of blasphemy - Mark 14:63,64

Jesus taken to Pilot - John 18:28-19:16

Out of envy the leading priests had arrested Jesus - Mark 15:10

Passover To The Cross - Part 8 - Cont'd

Mary and her sister are with John (we don't know when they would have connected with John that night) - John 19:25

Pilot offered to release one criminal, Barabbas or Jesus - John 18:38-40

Pilot says, "Take Him and crucify Him, I find no fault in Him." - John 19:6

Jesus was scourged - Mark 15:15

Guards had blindfolded Jesus and took turns punching Him and saying, "Prophecy" - Mark 14:65

Two other criminals were crucified with Jesus - Luke 23:32-33

Jesus cried out on the cross, "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do." - Luke 23:34

Jesus could have called 10,000 angels to aid Him - Matthew 26:53

Jesus asks John to take care of His mother from the cross - John 19:26-27

Jesus said, "It is finished." - John 19:30
