The Welcoming Christ—"I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life" John 14:6

The fourth window on the left is a memorial to the Fullilove family. This is one of two windows reserved for families whose members have long records of service to First Methodist dating from the 1800's. The stained glass window's center panel depicts Christ with outstretched arms proclaiming. 
