READ

Romans 5:1-2 (NRSV)

Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God.

Ephesians 2:4-8 (NRSV)

⁴ but God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us ⁵ even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— ⁶ and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ so that in the ages to come he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God...

REFLECT

Write down any thoughts or ideas to guide you this week:

Consider these questions:

- 'How is it with your soul?'
- 'Is the love of God shed abroad in your heart? Can you cry out, My God and my all? Do you love every man, even your enemies, the enemies of God, as your own soul? Yea, dost thou believe that Christ loved thee, and gave himself for thee?' (from the sermon *The Almost Christian*)
- Have you been through a 'storm' that tested your faith? How was your faith affected?
- Has there ever been a time when you have had to 'preach faith until you have faith?' How did you 'faith it til you made it?'
- When have you felt 'strangely warmed' by God's grace? How were you assured that you had received the gift of God's grace?
