SERMON: 'FREE FOR ALL'

READ

Ephesians 2:8-10 (NRSV)

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God — not the result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we may walk in them.

Romans 8:31-32 (NRSV)

What then are we to say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us? He who did not withhold his own Son but gave him up for all of us, how will he not with him also give us everything else?

REFLECT

Write down any thoughts or ideas to guide you this week:

Consider these questions:

- 'How is it with your soul?'
- What comes to mind when you hear the word 'grace'? Has it changed for you throughout your life? How have you experienced God's grace (prevenient, justifying, sanctifying)? How did you respond?
- Do you expect to be made perfect in this life? (keeping in mind Wesley's definition: perfect in love)

RESPOND
