SERMON: 'WHAT'S TO PREVENT ME?'

READ

Acts 8:35-38 (NRSV)

Then Philip began to speak, and starting with this scripture he proclaimed to him the good news about Jesus. ³⁶ As they were going along the road, they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water! What is to prevent me from being baptized?" ³⁸ He commanded the chariot to stop, and both of them, Philip and the eunuch, went down into the water, and Philip baptized him.

REFLECT

Write down any thoughts or ideas to guide you this week:

Read the rest of Philip's story in Acts 8, Peter and Cornelius in Acts 10, and the Jerusalem Council in Acts 15. Put yourself in their place, and imagine the difficulty in listening to the Holy Spirit over centuries of a particular Scriptural interpretation and tradition. Where do you see this today? Who are the Gentiles, Samaritans, Eunuchs, Corneliuses, and Sauls that the Holy Spirit may be sending us to today?

RESPOND

Pray the 'Shower Tag' prayer daily: 'Lord, as I enter the water to bathe, I remember my baptism. Wash me by your grace, fill me with your Spirit, renew my soul. I pray that I might live as your child today, and honor you in all that I do.'
