A Word from Pastor Libby

Friends,

In this season of Pentecost, which extends beyond the one day we call Pentecost the Holy Spirit takes us on a journey to learn about and engage with the Holy Spirit all the way into the fall. This is the longest continuous season of the church year for as



many as 28 weeks. The Holy Spirit though present from the time of creation, is rarely mentioned in the Bible until Jesus talks about the Holy Spirit coming to be our guide and our counselor. Yet the Holy Spirit is present in the Gospels before Jesus speaks his first word and is connected to Jesus "on all kinds of occasions in his lifebirth, baptism, temptation, preaching, healing, exorcisms, death and resurrection," says Clark Pinnock.

I think this is an important reminder for us that the Holy Spirit is found in numerous ways in our everyday lives. Every one of the places where the Holy Spirit was at work occurred only or mostly outside of a synagogue or temple, they were parts of Jesus everyday life. Through abundant images, "Hildegard of Bingen depicts Spirit in marvelous ways: as the life of creatures, as a burning fire that sparks, ignites, inflames and kindles our hearts; as a guide in the fog, a balm for wounds, a shining serenity and an overflowing fountain that spreads to all sides." (Clark Pinnock) I love these images as they remind us that even though we often aren't aware of it the Holy Spirit is ready to meet us right where we are, guiding us in unexpected ways to live the life we are called to as disciples of Jesus Christ.

Sometimes it will look like a gathering of women at United Women in Faith who spend time together sharing a devotion or learning more about our community and world to respond through prayer and service. Other times it is our Leadership Team who share a devotion before entering our work to be open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit as we lead the church in new directions and new ways. It can even look like a family picnic when we have a Block Party and neighbors, our new family, join us for an evening of conversation, food, games, and great music. People who didn't even realize how much they yearned for relationships with their neighbors until the Holy Spirit nudged them to come and they experienced neighboring with us.

Throughout my first two years here I have seen the Holy Spirit guiding us to see our ministry in new and expansive ways and I am so grateful we have followed our guidance that seems so mysterious yet is revealed in concrete ways of living and serving. I encourage us all to pray for the work of the Holy Spirit to be evident among us as we face changes on July 1 as the new appointive year begins and I begin serving ¾ time at Church of the Cross and ¼ time at Roxbury United Parish. When it comes to serving two churches there is always a need to adjust worship times to allow for time for a service in one location and travel time before the next service begins. Since Roxbury is a farming community and needs time to complete chores before worship, they will have worship at 11 am. This Sunday, June 4 we will have a discussion and come to a consensus about the new time for services at COC. I invite you to pray for the Holy Spirit to work among us to guide us as we determine our new worship time and create space for new ministries this year.

YMCA Grab N Go

Beginning Friday, May 19 Church of the Cross became the distribution site for the YMCA Grab N Go summer meal program. Each Friday from 3:30pm – 5:30pm volunteers hand out groceries for the week for each child age 3-18. This program helps support over 500 families each week. Part of this includes an activity sheet and devotion that goes to each family and is produced by Tara Baxter. She is able to put our church address, service times, and upcoming activities on these sheets.

Playground Update

You will notice a trailer in the south parking lot. This is the sign that construction will soon begin on the playground upgrade! We expect construction to begin around June 20th. Construction should take about 2-3 weeks weather permitting. 
