

A Word from Pastor Libby

Friends,

We are currently in a season on unknowns. Will I need a coat, shorts, an umbrella, or a snow shovel today? Mother Nature seems to be constantly changing her mind. It seems Father Time is on the same changing page as Mother Nature

as we again prepare to change our clocks as we spring forward again.

VANCO makes giving to COC easier than ever!

Visit www.coc-salina.org and click on "Give your offering to Church of the Cross by clicking here." This will allow you to either give through a recurring payment or a one-time payment.


Blessing Box

- Canned vegetables
- Crackers
- Grab and go snacks (we need a bunch)
- Macaroni and cheese.
