Second Level Japan Short Term Ministry Trip

Part 1: June 25th to July 8th - Osaka, Japan

Part 2: July 8th to July 15th - Tokyo, Japan

You may join us for either part or both. In Osaka, we will host Second Level Ministry's Mentorship Conference on July 5 & 6. This is a conference to help build up the Japanese church by encouraging disciple-making and equipping mentors. We will serve and visit current and future church partners in the area. In Tokyo, we will help sustain disciple-making efforts among the Japanese students who came to Atlanta by connecting them with churches. MTW Asia Pacific Area Retreat – 13 Aug–19 Aug, 2019

Description: The location is still to be determined, but it is looking like it may be Bali. Time at a beautiful beachside setting with our missionary kids (ages 8 and under - need people for Nursery aged 2 and under, Preschool 3-5 years old and Primary School aged 6-8 years old) while their parents spend time in worship, refreshment, and learning. You spend time with the kids for a few hours in the morning and then a couple of hours in late afternoon before dinner. We are asking that you raise support for this opportunity but don't want lack of funds to be a deterrent for you and there are some funds available to help supplement

Details: Cost is approx. \$800 plus airfare. Trip is for high school and adults.

Holy Land Vision/Ministry Trip – Oct 25-Nov 3, 2019

Description: Participating in a JGP vision trip is multifaceted: you will be able to see the historic sites, meet many partners in the region, spend a couple of days working alongside a partner to get to know each other and the local ministry, as well as worship with Christian partners from both cultural backgrounds.
