HOPE CREEK KIDS ONLINE WORSHIP SERIES WEEK THREE: THE LORD'S PRAYER

We've learned a lot about God in the Lord's Prayer these last two weeks! We learned first that He is a good Father who loves us no matter what and last week we learned that obeying Him is the best way to live. Today we are going to learn that JESUS WILL ALWAYS GIVE US WHAT WE NEED.

> Matthew 6:9-12 "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread."

Jesus calls Himself the Bread of Life in John 6:35, which is kind of weird but He explains why: "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." Jesus promises to always give us exactly what we need.

1. Family Discussion: Do your parents feed you every day? Stop and thank them for that! Have you ever worried that they wouldn't? Probably not! Think about why you haven't. It's probably because you know that they are GOOD parents—just like God is a GOOD FATHER—and will always give you what you need. (Even if it doesn't seem like what you think you need!)

2. Bottom Line: God will always give us what we need.

4. *Superbook* Episode: Watch *Superbook* Season 1 Episode 10 about Jesus' Last Supper with His disciples. When they eat the bread together He says His body is like the bread. As the Bread of Life, He meets our needs now BUT He has also met our biggest need when He died on the cross and forgiven our sin. (You can watch this while your parents watch the sermon.)
