Running from Sunday, Oct. 19th-Sunday, Nov. 19th, you will hear preaching, and lay witnesses, preaching and speaking about our response to the grace of God in our lives. 

After receiving the bread, one is free to receive the chalice. If you would prefer to receive the bread only, simply cross your arms in front of you. And, if you would prefer to receive a blessing only, please also signify by crossing your arms. Thank you.




