It's Generosity season at Messiah. Running from Sunday, Oct. 19th-Sunday, Nov. 19th, you will hear preaching, and lay witnesses, preaching and speaking about our response to the grace of God in our lives. This season will see the return of the two song praise set in place of the Gloria, and a change to the Gospel Acclamation, with the Gospel hymn Revive Us Again.
