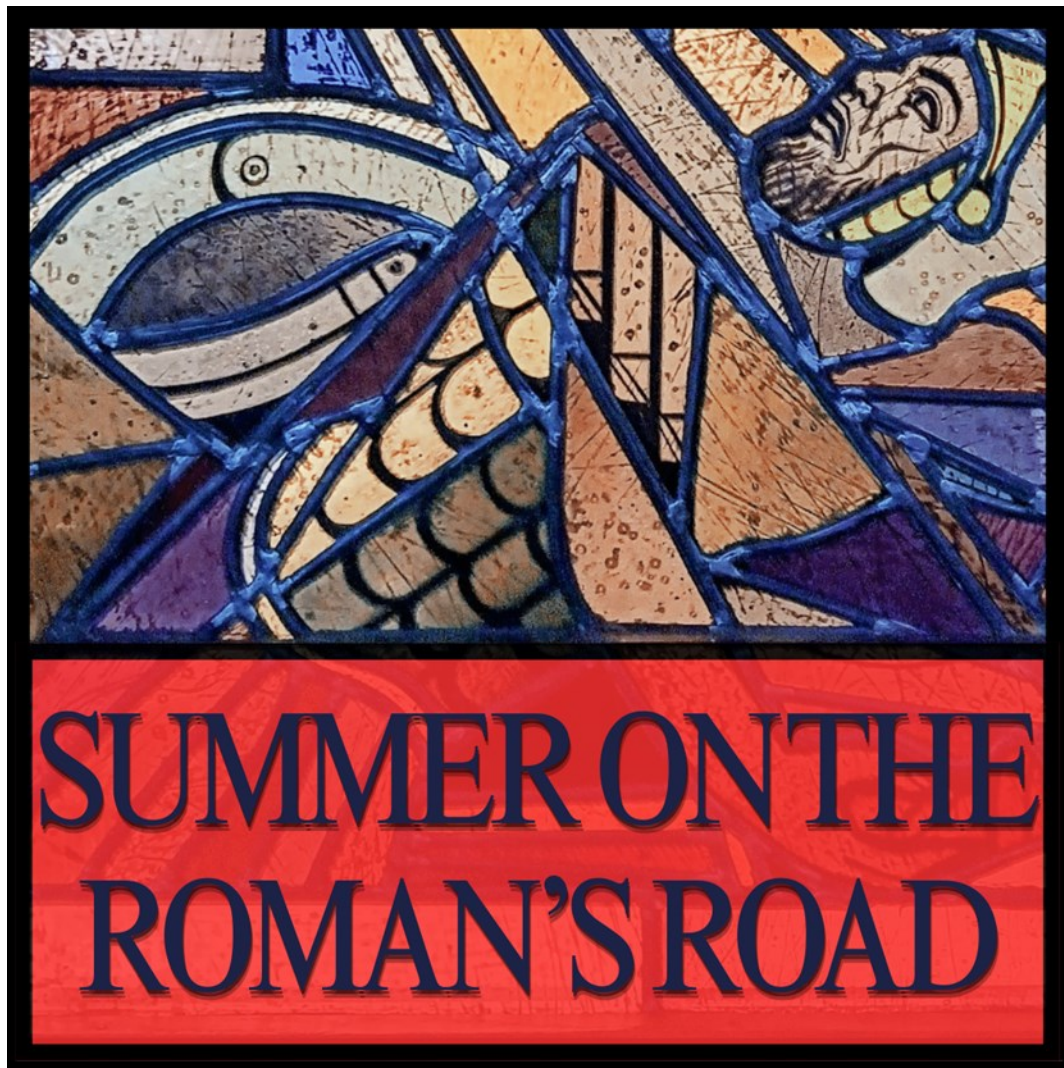

Summer Worship Notes.

As has been my Summer custom as Rector, we will preach from often ignored texts. Our theme: Summer on the Roman's Road. We'll preach from the Epistle readings beginning June 7th. From the fourth chapter of Romans in early June to the thirteenth chapter on Labor Day, we'll walk the Romans Road. For those unfamiliar, "the Romans Road" is a way of explaining the good news of salvation using verses from the Epistle to the Romans, like:

If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. –Romans 10:9

And we'll have a whole variety of guest preachers to complement our preaching bench of Joey Goodall, Fr. Marc, and me. Including the homecoming of postulants Paul Johnson and Kris Ferrario, and guest preachers from outside Messiah as well.

A Note for Visitors.

Resisting the urge to project our music and liturgy on screens, as Anglican Christians in the Episcopal Church we pray from the Book of Common Prayer and sing from our Hymnal. Other music is found in your worship bulletin. It is our custom to stand when we praise and profess, kneel when we pray, and sit when we listen. Our clergy will do our best to guide you, as will Messiah members.

Liturgy Changes.

Liturgically, we continue to use Eucharistic Prayer B and Prayer Form VI. We will acknowledge our sinfulness with the General Confession and hear the words of grace in the Absolution. We will also return to the one song Gloria after the Prayer of Humble Access, so that we get to sing all the songs at Holy Communion. All three readings will be read by our Lectors at the 8:30am service for the Summer.

A special note to visitors: If you are accustomed to receiving Holy Communion in your home Church, no matter what its denomination, you are also welcome to receive Holy Communion. After receiving the bread, one is free to receive the chalice. If you would prefer to receive the bread only, simply cross your arms in front of you. And, if you would prefer to receive a blessing only, please also signify by crossing your arms. Thank you.
