CampDocs Online Application Guide

What Is CampDocs?

CampDocs is an online camp registration service that we will be utilizing for Camp I-Vy this summer! You can register for Camp I-Vy online here: www.tinyurl.com/CampIvy2017

How Do I Apply For Camp I-Vy 2017?

As this is our first summer utilizing CampDocs we've put together this brief guide to walk you through the process:

1. Head to the Camp I-Vy 2017 registration portal and create an account on CampDocs: www.tinyurl.com/CampIvy2017
2. Once you have created your account click "Add Participant" on the left sidebar to add a profile for everyone applying for Camp I-Vy this summer.
3. For each applicant, select "Register For Session" and then select "Camper Application".
4. Decline the Protection Plan offered by Camp Docs. You will not need this for Camp I-Vy, click decline and move along.
5. Complete the registration forms. You can track your progress on the right sidebar; watch the red text flip to green as you complete each section! You can start the application and then come back later to finish it; all your information will save.
6. The application deadline is Friday June 2nd. You'll need to complete the entire process by then for your application to be considered. Once the deadline passes, you'll still be able to access your profile to update and information that might change prior to camp.
7. Once you have completed the process you'll be able to download the packing list and direction to camp!

How Will I Know If I'm Accepted? When Do I Pay The Camp Fee?

Once the application deadline on June 2nd has passed we will review the applications and send out acceptance packets the following week. Once an application packet has been received you'll be able to pay the camp fee of \$50 per camper, or request a financial aid form.

What Is The Application Priority?

A limited number of spots are available for Camp I-Vy. A completed application does not guarantee a spot at camp. Priority is given to applicants with a bleeding disorder (including carriers) and then siblings. Each application is time-stamped when it is received and at the deadline applications are reviewed in the order received.
