

There are two easy kinds of tournament gatherings you can have where it takes barely no set up at all!

One fun one is a Rock, Paper, Scissors tournament

For Rock, Paper, Scissors you can have everyone enter to be in the game for \$2 or 5\$ From there you can use a premade bracket (provided below, or you could create your own!) This is an easy way to raise funds while just having a normal get together with friends or family! Prizes can be as simple as a certificate!

The other easy one is Euchre! Many people already know how to play and you can charge even more for this one 10-15\$ This is another game that friends and families already like to get together and do for fun, so it is not hard to get people there and it won't cost you anything to run it(except buying playing cards)

For euchre there are a few ways to run a tournament. The way I would do it, is having randomized teams (pull names from a hat to make teams). Then rotate teams to play against each other, using a time limit (20 mins) to play as many hands as they can and the team that wins gets the difference of points at the end of the time limit(ex. Team A wins 7 hands and Team B wins 4 hands, Team A gets 3 points). At the end of the night the team with most points wins!

With these game nights you could easily raise a lot without having to put in a lot of effort and while just having fun with friends! Make it a potluck!
