# **Thanksgiving Morning Ministry**

Thanksgiving Day 2022 will again be a variation on our annual celebration of preparing meals and useful gifts on Thanksgiving morning.

Meals: Due to the care we are exercising about everyone's health, we will work with *Meals on Wheels* to prepare 135 turkey dinners complete with a slice of pumpkin pie. We will not be collecting canned vegetables this year. A community charity will deliver hot meals on Thanksgiving Day to local folks living in residential motels.

**Activities:** Christmas ornaments for our Thanksgiving meals, toiletry kits for the winter shelter, and other gifts will be made by small groups or by congregants at home. **Local Outreach** selected Literacy for Life, Meals on Wheels and the Pastors' Discretionary Fund. Literacy for Life is a local organization that provides tutoring and educational counseling. Meals on Wheels provides daily hot, nutritious meals to vulnerable adults and families in the Williamsburg area.

**The Pastors' Discretionary Fund** is a means to provide support for those in financial need within our community. Thanks to the generosity of our congregation, WUMC is usually able to fulfill referrals for aid from local helping agencies, including the WJCC Human Services, United Way and House of Mercy.

## **EMERGENCY HOMELESS SHELTER**

The winter winds will soon be blowing and churches throughout the Williamsburg area, including Williamsburg United Methodist Church, will be opening their doors to shelter our homeless neighbors. This shelter is an outreach of the **Community of Faith Mission (COFM)**. COFM is a faith-based emergency shelter program that serves those experiencing homelessness in the Greater Williamsburg community during the coldest months of the year. The COFM website can be accessed at: www.cofm.info Community of Faith Mission will be offering twelve (12) weeks of shelter during the coldest weeks of the season. **Our week of shelter is January 8 to January 15.** Volunteers from WUMC will be needed to staff on Sunday evening 1/8, Monday morning, 1/9, Friday evening 1/13, Saturday morning and evening 1/14 and Sunday morning 1/15.

Together with King of Glory Lutheran Church and the Christian Life Church we are signing up volunteers now to help with check-in in the evening, dinner, overnight, breakfast, and check-out in the morning as well as security/safety. Volunteer Training for all prospective volunteers will be held on Tuesday, November 15 from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. at the Williamsburg Community Chapel. This training will take less than an hour and a Q&A will be set aside at the end of the training. This training can be done in person or on Zoom.
