#### Keyboard

ECMS offers several adult Keyboard classes at various levels. Whether you are a complete beginner, a rusty returnee, or even an intermediate to advanced player, there are spots for you!

#### Youth Guitar 1

Youth Guitar Year 1 (ages 7+) is an exciting new class at ECMS that will approach Beginner Guitar Education with an emphasis on ensemble playing, music literacy, as well as music and motion concepts. The curriculum is written and developed by Anthony Williams, Director of ECMS. Anthony has been a professional guitarist for over a decade with experience in genres ranging from folk, jazz, classical, and rock. He has had the good fortune to study classical guitar with Larry Snitzler who was a member of the Andre Segovia master classes.

**Each guitar student will need their own nylon string guitar to bring to class. Written and listening curriculum will be provided as part of tuition.**

#### Adult Guitar True Beginner

Adult Guitar True Beginner is a new addition to the ECMS adult classes. This curriculum will use traditional beginner guitar methods from various published sources. Anthony has been a professional guitarist for over a decade with experience in genres ranging from folk, jazz, classical, and rock. Intended as recreational guitar playing, the classes are stress free, supportive and rewarding. Each guitar student will need their own guitar to bring to class.
