

## **Tom Marshall**

Organist

Tom joined the music ministry team at WUMC in October 2004. He holds degrees in organ and harpsichord performance from James Madison University and the University of Michigan. He was founding director of the Williamsburg Choral Guild, a charter member of the Southeastern Historical Keyboard Society, and has been a nearly lifelong member of the American Guild of Organists.

In addition to church music duties, Tom is a member of the artist-faculty at the College of William and Mary teaching harpsichord and piano and has developed a highly successful program of organ study boasting up to 15 organ students each semester. The WUMC serves as the main teaching/practice instrument for the college. He serves as harpsichordist for the Wren Masters, William and Mary's faculty Baroque ensemble.

As Organist at WUMC, he plays organ at most services in the church, and oversees the care and maintenance of the church's pipe organ, numerous quality pianos and its own exquisite replica of an 18th century French harpsichord.
