A Note From the Pastor

I don't know how many of you shop online. Of those of you who do, I have no idea which of you shop Amazon.com. First of all, this is **NOT** an enticement to get you to shop Amazon. I am writing to those who already use that service. It seems that through a program called Amazon Smile, Amazon will donate 5% of the purchase price of a sale to charity if you designate a charity for them to give to. Amazon donates to the selected charity out of their profits. I looked over the list of the approved charities and figured they were the usual ones and didn't think much more about it. Until I realized that we could put our church on the list. We have gotten that done and we are now an approved charity of Amazon Smile.

What does that mean to you? Well, if you are not a current Amazon shopper it means nothing at all. If on the other hand you do shop Amazon, I would ask you to designate First Baptist Cassville as your charity of choice. How do I do that? First go to amazon.com and sign in to your account. Next click on the drop down menu that says "Accounts & Lists." Most likely that pull down menu will appear in three columns: On the left will be "Buy it Again" and on the right will be "Your Account." In the middle column entitled "Your Lists" about 2/3 of the way down you will see "AmazonSmile Charity Lists." Click on that and then search for "First Baptist Cassville." Don't add church or MO, it will not come up right. When you see First Baptist Cassville come up click on it and it will tell you that you have selected our church as your preferred charity. This is where it gets a little tricky, EVERY time you go to Amazon to shop you have to go to the accounts and lists menu, select AmazonSmile and only then will that shopping session be included in the charitable program.

So again, please do not start shopping on Amazon if you do not already. I am not trying to make them wealthier or pull money from our local economy!!! This is just a potential revenue stream that we can use while the program remains in place.

If you try to do this and can't figure it out, call Scott Stearns. No, I'm just kidding. Call me and I will do my best to talk you through it. By the way I have yet to figure out how to do this from my phone, so you will probably have to do it from your computer or possibly a tablet. Have a wonderful week!
