

### **The Pastor's Corner**

I would like to call to your attention to our upcoming Global Impact Conference, March 27-31. For many of us this is old hat, but for others this will be your first experience and you may be wondering what it is all about. Let me explain. Historically, as Southern Baptists we talked about missions, we had groups that studied about missions and missionaries, we took up an annual offering to support missions through the International Mission Board and the North American Mission Board and we prayed for missions a couple of weeks each year. Several years ago, in 2000 to be exact, we adopted a new mission model and here is what it looks like:

1) A mission conference/celebration that we call a *Global Impact Celebration* (GIC). Eight to ten missionary families join us for five days of specially planned activities. These activities give the church family multiple opportunities to hear from the missionaries and about what God is doing around the world. It is also an opportunity to encourage God's workers who are serving full-time on the mission field.

2) Regular systematic giving to missions through our *Faith Commitment Offering* (FCO). It is a faith commitment between the giver and God. This model of giving exponentially increased the total amount given to mission causes around the world including the International Mission Board and North American Mission Board. During the GIC, we have the opportunity to make a faith commitment to missions.

3) *31-days of Prayer for Missions* is a prayer calendar we use that helps us be focused and intentional in praying for missions. Missionaries know that on their assigned day, many people at FBC Cassville are praying for them...they count on it! We call it "holding the ropes" in prayer.

4) After changing the mission model, we also have seen more of the FBC family involved in short-term mission endeavors. Nine families have gone to the mission field for extended periods of time. Currently, we have two families serving full-time in other countries.
