A Note From the Youth Minister

What does it mean to be blessed? Now many probably think of things like money, family, community, job, health or possessions. These are good things but often valued more than Jesus. In reality, Jesus speaks out about many of those things, such as the evils of money and the misuse of resources. We often use our resources to boast about ourselves instead of the one who made them. But the best blessings are not these *things*, but rather seeking after God's kingdom. If we want to find what it means to be blessed, an easy place to look is the beatitudes.

God's blessing is shown right here at the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount. Are you poor in spirit? You are blessed. Are you mourning? You are blessed. Are you meek? You are blessed. Do you hunger and thirst for righteousness? You are blessed. Do you show mercy? You are blessed. Are you pure in heart? You are blessed. Are you a peacemaker? You are blessed. Are you persecuted because of righteousness? You are blessed. Are you insulted, persecuted, and falsely accused because you are a follower of Christ? You are blessed.

God's blessing does not come to those whom we see as "blessed." It is to the lowly, the downcast, the cast out. So, as Christians, let us not be blessed in the way the world sees, having power, influence, money, etc., but instead let's be blessed by God and walk the way that Jesus walked.
