### The Pastor's Corner

Spiritual darkness is not just a problem for those on earth. Spiritual darkness leads to eternal darkness that Jesus describes as a place where there is weeping and gnashing of teeth. I have preached on hell twice in the last couple of years, but in all honesty you don't hear about it that much from preachers today. Maybe it's an overreaction to the old "hell-fire and damnation" preachers of days gone by, or perhaps it just doesn't seem effective in growing churches in a country where "everything" is ok. My problem with shying away from this topic is Jesus. He spent a lot of His teaching time on the topic. In Acts 26 Paul is recounting his epiphany with Jesus to King Agrippa and quotes Jesus saying: "...to appoint you as a servant and witness to the... Gentiles—to whom I am sending you to open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me" (Acts 26:16b-18 ESV). Spiritual darkness is a terrible and unimaginable fate. If we truly love lost people we must, at the very least, warn them of the consequences of their spiritual choice. I hope to see you Sunday as we consider "Turning from the Darkness to the Light." Shalom.
