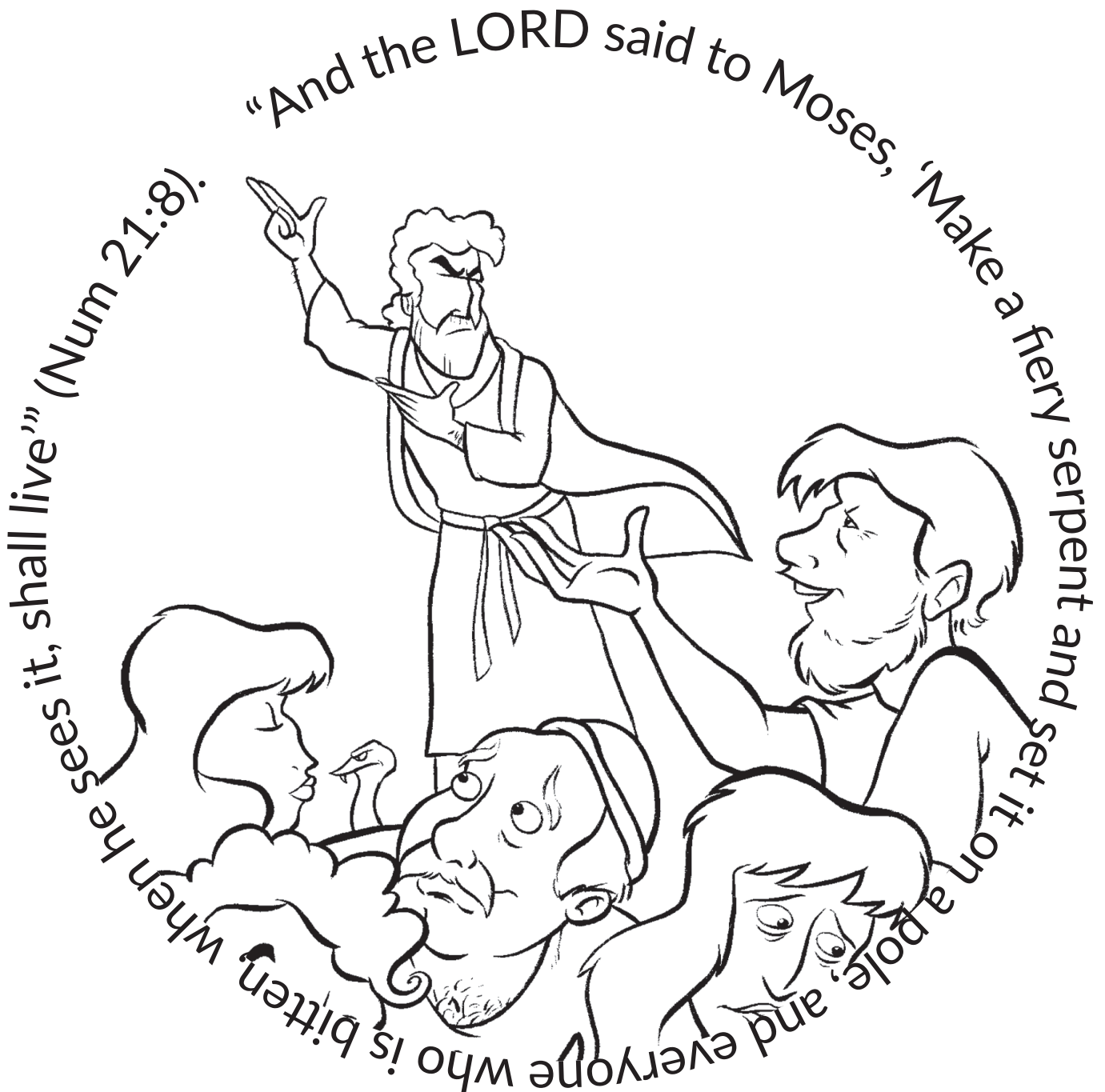

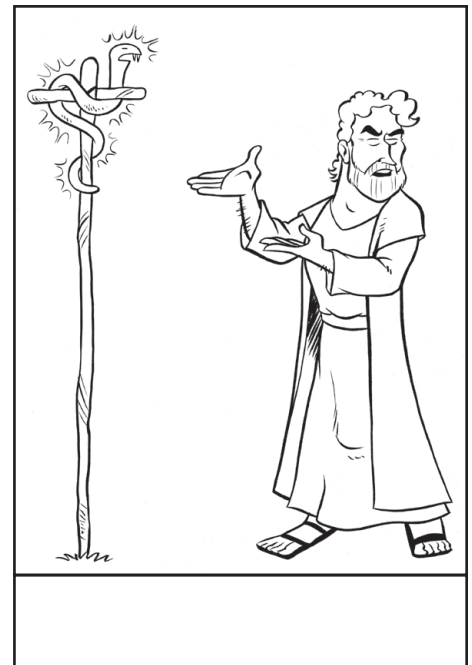
Serpent Pop-Up Book

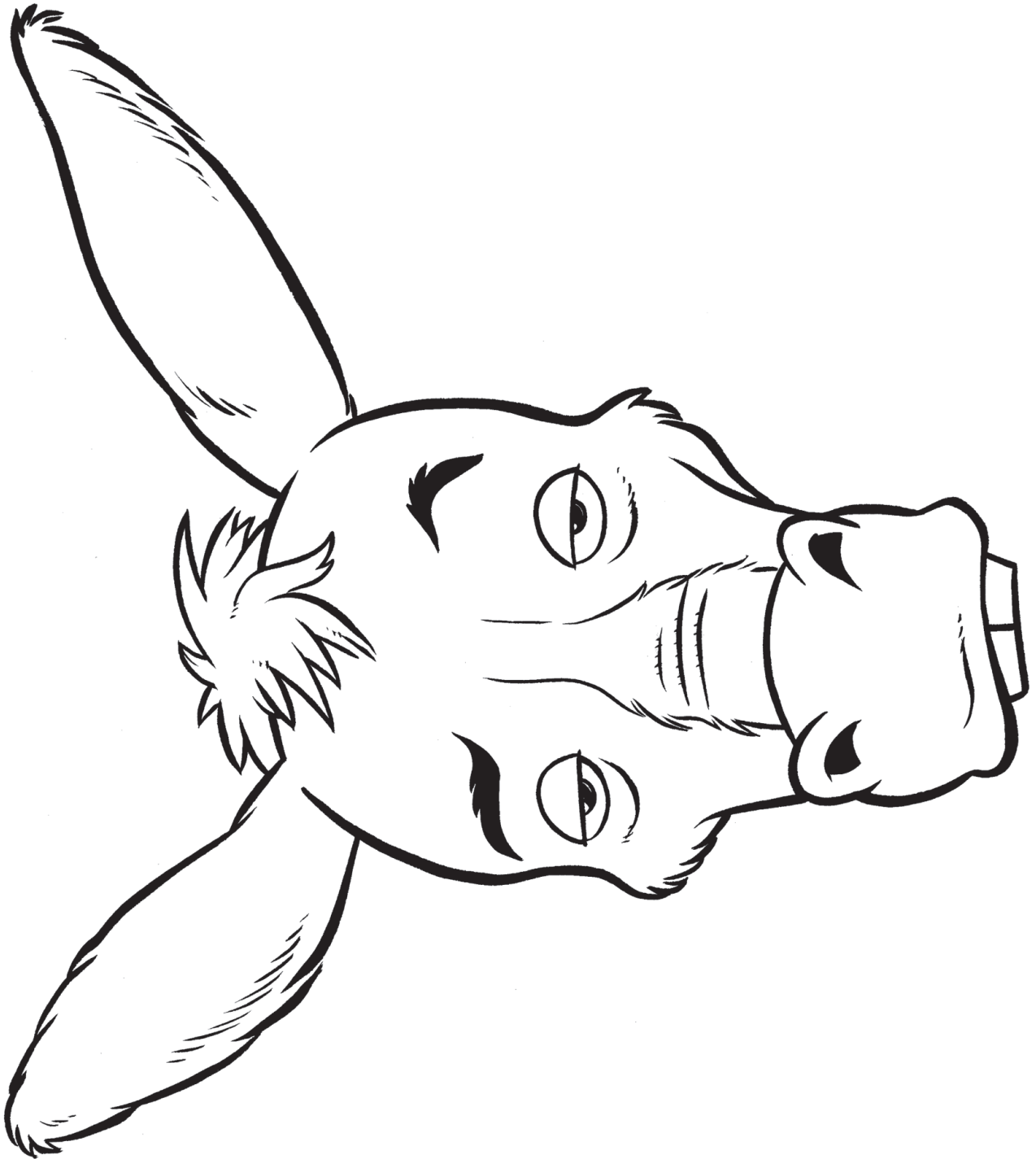

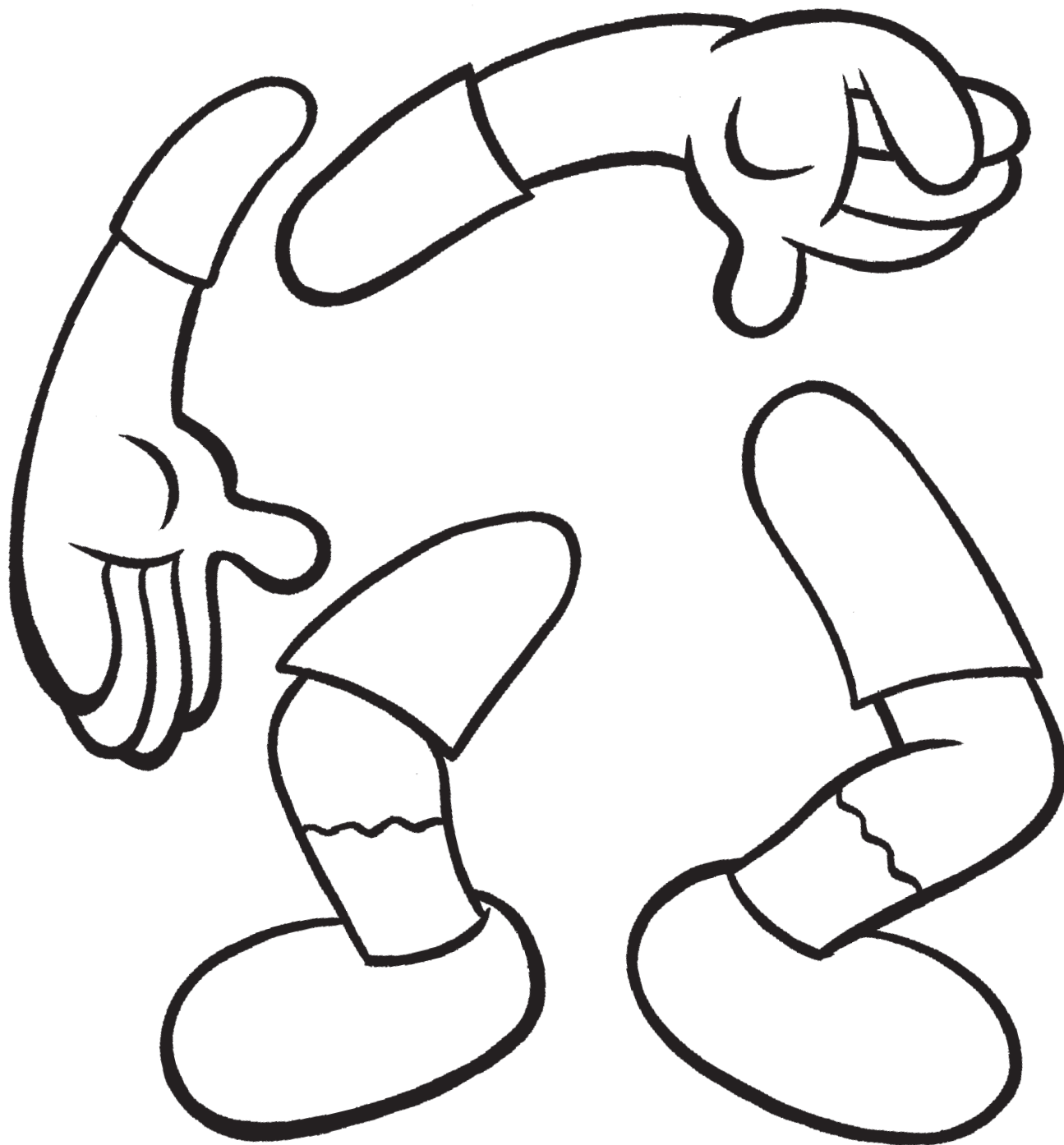
