We have a small group that meets in the town they are from, and we are encouraging them to join this group.

I meet with him weekly and we study the Bible together. And **pray** for David, a young man who became a Christian a couple of years ago and now wants to get baptized. He has been off and on since becoming a Christian, but now seems more serious about growing in his relationship with Jesus.
