SENIOR PASTOR REPORT

Growing up, my favorite comic strip was *Peanuts* by Charles Schulz. It features Charlie Brown, who has been billed as everyone's lovable loser. Whenever Charlie Brown finds himself in a less than desirable position, he utters his hallmark expression, "GOOD GRIEF!!".

2020 has been a year that, if you open your doors and listen to your community, not a day would go by that you wouldn't have heard that same phrase, "GOOD GRIEF!", being expressed. Doubtlessly, everyone in our congregation has either uttered this term or at least one similar to it.

It has been a year of grief. There were many losses from funerals, of course. Even in the events that were meant to hold our joy, such as weddings, there would often be a cloud of sadness hovering nearby. Our highs seemed to not be as high and the lows were lower. It was difficult to rejoice with brides and grooms via Vimeo (online). It was harder to do pre-marital counseling over Zoom than face-to-face. It was hardest to witness the sadness of a family at a joyous wedding which was missing members due to the virus. I have also watched as a number of the Tuesday night group, the "Menno Misfits", drop off and spin out this year (I have tears streaming down my face as I type this). In the last several months, almost a dozen who would have attended our group have been arrested for some reason or another. In my pain over this, the words "GOOD GRIEF" don't seem adequate. I have seen more issues in families this year than any other year since I have been in ministry. This year has been hard on everyone; it has been a year that can be defined as "GOOD GRIEF!".

On top of all the 2020 pain and struggle, we also saw the departure of two dearly-loved and long-serving staff members. Renee and Judy retired from their positions at First Mennonite this year. Renee we still see (and have been praying fervently for). For Judy, on the other hand, it wasn't enough to leave First Menno—she left the state. While it is sad not to have them in the office any longer, Jen and Joanne have been doing an excellent job learning the ropes and keeping the ministry of the church moving forward. Also, this year saw the end of Bill in the position of the youth pastor. It was emotional seeing so many moist eyes in the youth as Bill announced his resignation. That is a testament to the connection he made with our youth. The timing turned out well, however, as Seth Ringger was completing his assignment at his mission's program when Bill was announcing his resignation. Seth has agreed to lead the youth until the fall. We are excited by this as he is known by the youth, and he will bring some stability as the kids don't have to get to know someone new during this transition.

As I reflect on a year that has brought so much pain, confusion, and grief into the life of our church and beyond, I look at even the changes that have happened in our staffing. While there is sorrow in the changes, God provides blessings and the ministries continue.

I look at 2020 and I see the GRIEF in it; but do I see the GOOD as well? Do I see the glimpses of God in the midst of the pain? The wonderful thing about our faith is that it points us beyond our present situation and helps us catch a glimpse of a God who is GOOD all the time. So while we are in the midst of pain and struggle, my prayer is that our Grief can also be Good, because HE is Good. While 2021 doesn't seem to be starting any better than 2020 ended, **Hebrews 12:2 says, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."** When our eyes are fixed on Him, he can turn our Grief into GOOD grief.
