SENIOR PASTOR REPORT

Deuteronomy 4:9–10 *Only be careful, and watch yourselves closely so that you do not forget the things your eyes have seen or let them slip from your heart as long as you live. Teach them to your children and to their children after them.*

Remember the day you stood before the LORD your God at Horeb, when he said to me, “Assemble the people before me to hear my words so that they may learn to revere me as long as they live in the land and may teach them to their children.”

We are told many times throughout Scripture to “do not forget” and to “remember.” Yet how often do we neglect this command of Scripture? How often do we take time to remember the past year? We can allow days to become years without looking back and reflecting on what has been.

The year 2025 marked the 500th anniversary of the Anabaptist movement. With that in mind, we began the year with a series on the lasting impact of the Anabaptists on the broader evangelical church. These included the separation of church and state. The early Anabaptists paid dearly for standing firm that these are two separate entities. We also looked at the ban—that church discipline involves excommunication, not death, for those considered to be in error. Another key belief is that the church is a confessing church: one enters by confession and baptism, not simply because they were born in a certain region. Finally, we examined their call to discipleship—that the Christian life is not defined by where you worship on Sunday morning, but by whether you are living like Jesus day to day. These are foundational truths we never want to lose.

We also journeyed through 1 Corinthians, seeing the role of the Spirit in the life of the local church and recognizing that the Spirit of God continues to move through the church today. On the first Sunday of three different months, we focused on specific spiritual gifts and how they operate in the church today, with the hope that the Spirit of God will continue to move in our midst. On the other Sundays, we worked through the book of Nehemiah and the rebuilding of the wall around Jerusalem.

In 2025, 17 new members chose to join the church, either through baptism or upon their confession of faith. It is always exciting when people choose to covenant together and journey as the people of God in a local fellowship. Leading up to eight of those baptisms, Bill, Jess Meyer, and I took our biennial catechism trip to Pennsylvania. It is always a good time getting to know the young people and seeing them interact with one another around matters of faith during both the class and the trip.

This year also saw me travel to Pennsylvania four times: first for the 500th anniversary of Anabaptism, then for catechism, next for an annual leadership equipping event for credentialed leaders, and finally for a meeting with other churches regarding our Sunday School material. In October, I had the opportunity to travel to Albania with Global Disciples and help teach small business material to believers from a Muslim background.

I continue to meet on Tuesday nights with the group affectionately known as the “1st Menno Misfits”. It has been a joy to see some really grasp the faith and grow deeply, while at the same time it is heartbreaking to see others struggle and drift away. As in other years, ministry has included walking with people through both the highs (baby dedications, premarital counseling, weddings, etc.) and the lows (struggling marriages, crisis events, funerals, and more).

On a family vacation, we had the opportunity to travel to Switzerland and experience its beautiful scenery, as well as visit historical Anabaptist sites. We also saw the places Megan’s family was forced to leave—the Emmental—and where they later settled in the Jura mountain region. Sharing with the boys about their ancestry and what their forebearers were willing to endure for their faith made this a very meaningful trip.

This year also marked my crossing over 16 years as your pastor. It is hard to believe it has been that long. I came to First Mennonite with some fear and trepidation. If someone had told me then how good it would be, I would not have believed them. The reason is this congregation—a people who love not only the Book of the Lord, but the Lord of the Book.
