We can hardly believe one full month of Preschool is done. Most of the children have adjusted to the routine, to each other, and to us. Each child's unique personality is beginning to shine, and that makes every class special.

<u>Field Trips.</u> On Tuesday September 30, we will be visiting Phil Eicher's Woods. Phil is a gifted teacher of nature, wildlife and God's creation.
