Christmas at the Movies - Mary, The Special One

Luke 1:26-37

²⁶ Now in the sixth month [of Elizabeth's pregnancy] the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city in Galilee called Nazareth, ²⁷ to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, a descendant of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. ²⁸ And coming to her, the angel said, "Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you." 29 But she was greatly perplexed at what he said, and kept carefully considering what kind of greeting this was. 30 The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 Listen carefully: you will conceive in your womb and give birth to a son, and you shall name Him Jesus. 32 He will be great and eminent and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David; 33 and He will reign over the house of Israel forever, and of His kingdom there shall be no end." 34 Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin and have no intimacy with any man?" 35 Then the angel replied to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you [like a cloud]; for that reason the holy (pure, sinless) Child shall be called the Son of God. ³⁶ And listen, even your relative Elizabeth has also conceived a son in her old age; and she who was called barren is now in her sixth month. ³⁷ For with God nothing [is or ever] shall be impossible." 38 Then Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; may it be done to me according to your word." And the angel left her.

Luke 2:10 – Behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all people.

1. Despite Mary's Fears, She Trusted God's Word and Guidance for Her Life.

Luke 1:29 - "Mary was greatly troubled at his words,"

Luke 1:38, Mary proclaims "I am the Lord's servant, and tells Gabriel, "May your word to me be fulfilled."

2. In the Midst of Mary's Trials, She Continued to Praise God.

1 Peter 4:12-13 – "Beloved, do think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange things has happened to you; but rejoice... and be glad with exceeding joy."

3. Mary Trusted God in the Unknown

Proverbs 3:5-6 – Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not to your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will direct your paths.

4. Mary Surrendered to God's Will

Proverbs 22:4 (TPT) – Laying your life down in tender surrender before the Lord will bring life, prosperity, and honor as your reward.

5. Mary's Suffering Drew Her Closer to God

Deuteronomy 31:8 - "The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."

Proverbs 19:23 (TPT) – When you live a life of abandoned love, surrendered before the awe of God, here's what you'll experience: Abundant life. Continual protection. Complete satisfaction.
