Idiom – is an expression in the usage of a language that is peculiar to itself either in having a meaning that cannot be derived from the conjoined meanings of its elements (such as *up in the air* for "undecided") or in its grammatically atypical use of words (such as *give way*).

Break the Ice *Meaning: To get the conversation started or going*

A Dime a Dozen Meaning: Very common

Bite the Bullet *Meaning: Doing something that you really don't want to do*

Under the Weather *Meaning: Describing that you are not feeling well* **Selling Like Hotcakes** *Meaning: To sell quickly or be in high demand*

Your Guess is as Good as Mine Meaning: I have no idea or I don't know either

Piece of Cake *Meaning: It was easy*

Once in a Blue Moon *Meaning: Very rare*

It's Not Rocket Science

Meaning: It's not as hard or difficult as you think

Spill the Beans Meaning: To tell a secret

I'm Just Passing Though. It means traveling or going through an area with the intention of not staying long or not staying at all.
