

## **I'm Just Passing Through**

Isaiah 43:1-3 (NLT)

<sup>1</sup>But now, O Jacob, listen to the Lord who created you. O Israel, the one who formed you says, "Do not be afraid, for I have ransomed you. I have called you by name; you are mine. <sup>2</sup>When you go through deep waters, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown. When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up; the flames will not consume you. <sup>3</sup>For I am the Lord, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.

**Idiom** – is an expression in the usage of a language that is peculiar to itself either in having a meaning that cannot be derived from the conjoined meanings of its elements (such as *up in the air* for "undecided") or in its grammatically atypical use of words (such as *give way*).

### **Break the Ice**

*Meaning: To get the conversation started or going*

### **A Dime a Dozen**

*Meaning: Very common*

### **Bite the Bullet**

*Meaning: Doing something that you really don't want to do*

### **Under the Weather**

*Meaning: Describing that you are not feeling well*

### **Selling Like Hotcakes**

*Meaning: To sell quickly or be in high demand*

### **Your Guess is as Good as Mine**

*Meaning: I have no idea or I don't know either*

### **Piece of Cake**

*Meaning: It was easy*

### **Once in a Blue Moon**

*Meaning: Very rare*

## **It's Not Rocket Science**

*Meaning: It's not as hard or difficult as you think*

## **Spill the Beans**

*Meaning: To tell a secret*

**I'm Just Passing Though.** It means traveling or going through an area with the intention of not staying long or not staying at all.
