Mountains are significant throughout the Bible. They are mentioned frequently in the Bible because the landscape where the stories in the Bible take place is a mountainous area. As a result, mountains and hills are mentioned more than 500 times in Scripture. Mountains have a logical religious symbolism for Jewish and Christian cultures since they are sometimes considered closer to God or closer to Heaven. As a result, God often reveals himself on a mountaintop in the Bible.
