1. The SETTING

Acts 2:1 (NLT) 1 On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place.

- **3 Historical Insights into Pentecost**
- 1. Pentecost was a pilgrim festival.
- 2. Pentecost was a holiday.
- 3. There were certain celebrations and sacrifices and offerings which were prescribed in the Law for the day of Pentecost.

Psalm 133:1-3 (MEV) 1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brothers to dwell together in unity! **2** It is like precious oil upon the head, that runs down on the beard— even Aaron's beard—and going down to the collar of his garments; **3** as the dew of Hermon, that descends upon the mountains of Zion, for there the Lord has commanded the blessing, even life forever.

Acts 2:43-44 (NIV) 43 Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. **44** All the believers were TOGETHER and had everything in common.

2. The SOUND

Acts 2:2 (NLT) 2 Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting.

3. The SIGHT

Acts 2:3 (NLT) 3 Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them.

4. The SPEECH.

Acts 2:4 (NLT) 4 And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages or tongues, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.

Acts 2:4 (NKJV) They began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

- -The Holy Spirit wants to invade you, He wants control of all of your life!
- -The Holy Spirit wants to **envelop** you, He wants to bring you out and deliver you!
- -The Holy Spirit wants to **instruct** you, He wants to teach you and show you the will of God for your life!
- -The Holy Spirit wants to **impress** you, The Old Timers would call this "getting the witness." He wants to tell you things that you would not know on your own!
- -The Holy Spirit wants to **indwell**, He wants to be permanently present.
