

# NSP Witnessing Values

## We Value that...

### 1. Believers clearly understand and articulate the gospel.

We want you to clearly understand the powerful and transformational message of the gospel. Are you able to explain the essential components of the gospel? Are you foggy about what the message truly is? It's easy to get sidetracked by the nonessential components of Christianity rather than sharing the main points of the message.

### 2. Believers share the gospel with students who do not know Christ.

We recognize that many students do not attend church and have limited or no knowledge of the good news of Jesus Christ. We want to share it with them. We want to equip you to go out and share Christ with the thousands of students who have never heard the gospel.

### 3. Believers share the gospel clearly.

It is one thing to know what the gospel includes, and it is another to know how to share the message clearly so anyone can understand. Sometimes, believers can confuse people about what it means to follow Christ because they have not been trained to share in a way that is simple and easy for non-Christians to understand.

### 4. Believers share the gospel with biblical content.

We want to teach you to use Scripture to share Christ. "The word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword" (Heb. 4:12). What better way to convict a heart and speak truth to a student than through the Word of God?

### 5. Believers share the gospel confidently.

We want to give you many opportunities to share your faith with others in order to boost your confidence. The more you share, the easier it will get. You will see how many students actually want to talk about the Lord. You will be able to share the message without stumbling over your words. You will be more comfortable starting conversations about Christ. The more you share Christ now, the more confident you will be to have Christ-centered conversations in any setting, with anyone.

### 6. Believers share the gospel transferably.

As you have conversations with students about Christ, one of two things will happen: they will either accept Him or they won't. Regardless, you want to provide them with the tools needed to start a relationship with Christ. Handing them a gospel booklet will allow them to see the components of a decision to follow Christ. The booklet will also teach them how to walk with Christ. Taking the booklet home will let them re-read it, allowing the Holy Spirit to continue to work in their heart, and remember your conversation. They can even share the truth of the gospel with others in their lives by walking them through the booklet as well.
