

TOPICS FOR FOLLOW-UP CLUB MEETINGS

After your Outreach Week, there will be students hungry to learn more! They will want a place to go and get questions answered without judgment. Help these people walk toward Christ in a whole new way by planning follow-up focused club meetings to help them grow in their understanding of Christ and what it means to be a follower of Him. Below is an extensive list of topic ideas that you can choose from to create a unique series for your follow-up club meetings.

Pray as a leadership team for God to guide your decision-making as you choose topics for follow-up. Trust that He will provide you the wisdom you need to know how to be best teach students on your campus what it means to follow Christ.

Select your topics ahead of time so you can effectively promote your meetings on campus and help students know what will be happening. This will also make it easier for you to find appropriate speakers to teach the message. You could have a different club leader give a message each week for the course of your series (or each day of your Follow-Up Week). Or, if the topics you choose are more difficult, you can invite different youth pastors to come speak on each of those. Maybe there is even someone in your church that specializes in apologetics that you can invite! Pray and ask God to lay on your heart who the right person is to speak. Trust that He will provide!

Note

You can also teach on these topics in your normal club meetings throughout the year. You don't have to limit them to your follow-up club meetings.

POSSIBLE FOLLOW-UP TOPICS:

1 Christian Doctrine

- The Holy Spirit's Role in the Life of a Christian

- The Attributes of God
- Heaven & Hell
- Sin & Spiritual Warfare

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2 More of the Bible

- Bible Study: The Importance of Reading the Bible, How to Read the Bible, Bible Memorization, Suggested Bible Reading Plan
- Old Testament: Importance & Overview
- The Basic Teachings & Commands of Jesus
- Books of the Bible (i.e. Mark and John)

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3 Christian Practices

- Church Involvement: Getting Involved Locally
- Prayer: Why Pray, How to Pray, & Examples
- Sharing your Faith: Why & How
- Baptism: What it Represents, Why & How
- Worship
- Confession
- Forgiveness

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4 Apologetics and Questions

- The Existence of God
- Why Does God Allow Evil?
- Why Does God Allow People to go to Hell?
- What is the Purpose of the Christian Life?
- Evolution vs. Creation

- The Resurrection
