When are we leaving and coming back?

Check in begins Sunday, June 17 at 9:30pm from the Atrium (downtown campus).

What is the cost and what does it cover?

The cost of the trip is \$395. There is a \$50 deposit due at signup. It includes all travel, lodging, meals, t-shirt, rec, speaker, band, etc. The only thing not covered will be three travel meals to/from Destin plus additional money for souvenirs or personal spending (parent discretion).

Where will we be staying?

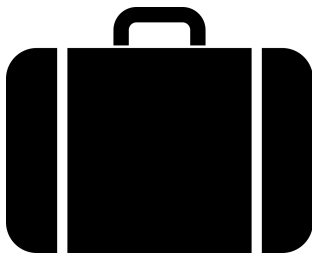
Seascape Resort, 112 Seascape Drive, Destin, FL 32550

PACKING

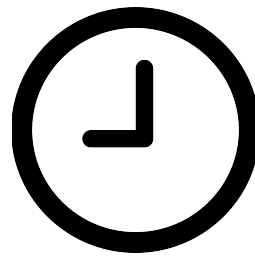
what to bring
what not to bring

What to bring:

- Bible and pen
- TOWELS! Make sure you have plenty of towels as towels are not provided.
- Casual clothing for 5 days
- Free time beach attire for 4 days
- Swimsuits (For girls: one piece or a tankini that covers the midriff)
- Toiletries (Toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, sunscreen, etc.)
- Tennis shoes and sandals
- Spending money for 3 fast food meals during travel and any souvenirs and snacks.
- Medications (must be checked in with camp staff)
- Camp T-shirt (wear on last) day

What not to bring:

- Short shorts
- No halter tops, or tube tops.
- Clothes with questionable or inappropriate slogans.
- Fireworks, Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, or Weapons!
- Nothing for pranks: shaving cream, water balloons, etc.
