

# Hosanna!

Read: **Mark 11:1-10** And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples,

2 And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose him, and bring him.

3 And if any man say unto you, Why do ye this? say ye that the Lord hath need of him; and straightway he will send him hither.

4 And they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door without in a place where two ways met; and they loose him.

5 And certain of them that stood there said unto them, What do ye, loosing the colt?

6 And they said unto them even as Jesus had commanded: and they let them go.

7 And they brought the colt to Jesus, and cast their garments on him; and he sat upon him.

8 And many spread their garments in the way: and others cut down branches off the trees, and strawed them in the way.

9 And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna; Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord:

10 Blessed be the kingdom of our father David, that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest.

Have you ever attended a parade or watched one on television? There are people you know, happy faces, bands, floats, sometimes candy, and much more. Jesus asked two disciples to go get a colt in town. They brought the colt back to Jesus, placed garments on the colt, and then Jesus got on for a ride. Jesus was in the parade. People lined the streets. They put their clothes in the streets and waved palm branches. They followed Jesus shouting, "Hosanna; Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord...Hosanna in the highest." They were excited to see Jesus and they praised Him.
